



CERTIFICATE OF PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCE
MANAGEMENT COURSE – 6 Day Course

For those wishing to undertake employment in the Road Haulage Industry as a transport manager or owner operator, are required by the Road Traffic Act to undertake the course of instruction and pass the test standards set by The Royal Society of Arts, Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC) and Oxford, Cambridge & Royal Society of Arts Examination Board (OCR).

Courses are held four times a year. Examinations can only be held at examination centres. We currently have our own examination centres in Stanford-le-Hope, Essex and West Lothian, Scotland or there are centres nationally that you can book yourselves.

Students wishing to hold an operators licence National and International are required to satisfy the Licence Authority that they meet the criteria laid down by the law.

1. They are of good repute
2. They have significant financial resources
3. They are professional competent

Each student receives a full set of course notes and stage tests.

Please note: If a reader is required on the examination day the cost for this will be £75.00.

In order to be awarded their certificate, students must pass Units 1, 2 and 4 in National and Unit 6 for International. Any candidates failing any one of the units may re-sit them at the next examination date.

Examinations must be booked no later than **4 weeks** prior to the examination date.

PLEASE NOTE: Proof of identification is required i.e. passport, photographic drivers licence or a signed declaration by a JP, Police Officer, Minister of the Church, Family Doctor, Senior Public Servant or Professional Person who *must* state the number of years he/she has known the candidate (for examination day).

Students are advised to bring with them a highlighter pen, calculator and one passport size photograph.

Students are asked to be at the centre for **08.30** hrs on the first day of the course, and on the examination day please ensure you are at the centre by **09.00** hrs. If you are going to arrive outside these hours please be kind enough to inform us in advance.

Basic Home Study – This is available for those persons who are unable to attend one of the above courses. As with the above National & International course each student receives a full set of course notes once full payment has been received.

Within this basic package you will receive a pack of course notes, and included within this will be stage questions, modular case studies and example examination papers.

There is also a workshop day, which you are under no obligation to attend; it does give you the opportunity to go over anything you are unsure of, or if you would like anything explained to you by the Instructor.
